

Yakima RackandRoll Trailer Warranty

Warranty

Subject to the exceptions noted below, Yakima RackandRoll Trailer warranty extends to the original purchaser for one (1) year from the date of the original retail purchase of the trailer and / or accessories. Yakima will remedy defects in the materials or workmanship during the one-year warranty period by exercising the option to repair or replace the defective component(s), without charge for part or labor to the original purchaser, proof of purchase is required.

The purchaser will be responsible for the cost of shipping the component(s) to Yakima for evaluation. Please contact us at 888-925-4621 for a return authorization number (RA), and shipping instructions. No returns will be accepted without a valid RA number.

Exceptions – What Your Warranty Does Not Cover

Warranty coverage does not include repair or replacement of parts that are modified by the user or parts subject to normal wear such as, tires, tubes, and paint chips caused by road debris or other sources.

No warranty is given for defects resulting from conditions beyond Yakima's control including, but not limited to, misuse, overloading, or failure to adhere to Yakima's instructions or guidelines.

No warranty is given for defects caused by accidents or unlawful vehicle operation. No warranty is given for defects caused by the user's failure to secure cargo as recommended.

Repair or replacement of the defective Yakima product is the original purchaser's exclusive remedy under this warranty. All consequential and incidental damages are excluded under this warranty. Damage to the original purchaser's vehicle, cargo, or to any other person or property is excluded.

Claims by the original purchaser are limited from the date of the original retail purchase to one year. Some states do not allow the exclusion or limitation of the incidental or consequential damages, or limitations on how long an implied warranty last, so the above limitations may not apply to you. This warranty gives you specific rights and you may have other rights, which vary from state to state.
